3 Installation





3.1 Connecting a third-party fuel line fitting

The pickup assembly must be removed from the fuel tank before connecting the fuel line fitting.

1. Be sure the fuel tank is empty.




1	Pickup assembly (hex cap model)	3	Pickup assembly (hand-tighten cap model)
2	Fuel tank		


2. Carefully unscrew the pickup assembly from the fuel tank.



NOTE If the pickup assembly cannot be loosened by hand, an adjustable wrench or slip-joint pliers may be used. Take care not to damage the pickup assembly cap or threads.




3. Apply thread-sealing tape to the threads on the fuel line fitting.





4. Hand-tighten the fuel line fitting to the pickup assembly; then tighten another quarter turn with a wrench.




1	Pickup assembly (hex cap model)	3	Pickup assembly (hand-tighten cap model)

5. Hand-tighten the pickup assembly to the fuel tank.

3.2 Replacing the pickup assembly


These steps describe how to replace a pickup assembly that has a hand-tighten cap model with a pickup assembly that has a hex cap model.

1. Be sure the fuel tank is empty.




1	Pickup assembly (hand-tighten cap	2	Fuel tank

2. Unscrew and remove the pickup assembly (hand-tighten cap model) from the fuel tank.



- 1 Threaded coller 2 Fuel tank
- Remove the threaded collar from the fuel tank.Channel lock pliers can be used to loosen the collar, if necessary.
- 4. Remove the thin gasket.
- 5. Verify that the new gasket with the smaller inner diameter is installed on the new pickup assembly (hex cap model) fuel tube.

- 6. Insert the pickup assembly (hex cap model) into the fuel tank.
- 7. Hand-tighten the hex cap.
